Residence

Live in central Montreal,
or close to a bus or metro station.

Travel

Own a car
or have access to public transportation.

Role of Host Families

- The role of host families is central to the participants' experience throughout the competition.
- Offer hospitality
- Welcome your artist upon arrival at the airport and accompany him or her upon their departure
- Integrate the artist into your family by providing a complimentary room and meals (including breakfast and dinner) for the duration of the artist's stay
- Drive/accompany your artist to various CMIM events when possible
- Provide the competitor with the opportunity to practice at home, if you have a piano, or help to identify the nearest rehearsal location (from a list to be provided by the CMIM)
- Depending on your availability and their interest, show your pianist around the city

Schedule

Each artist's schedule varies according to the order in which they will perform and their progress in the competition.

How does it work?

Simple and easy:

- Let us know that you are interested in hosting an artist
- A member of the CMIM team will contact you to find out about your profile, preferences, restrictions, etc.
- The CMIM confirms your registration as a Piano 2024 host family
- The CMIM matches you with a pianist (March 2024)
- You may be in touch with your artist by email ahead of the competition

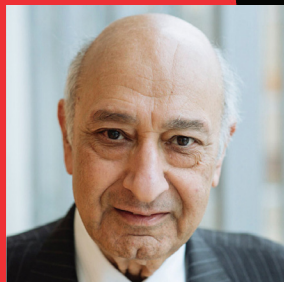

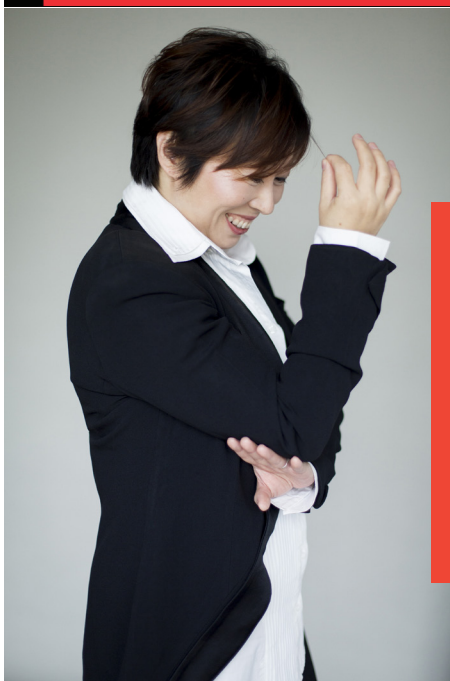
