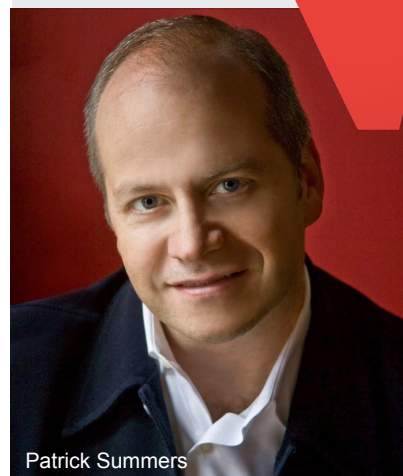
From **May 25 to June 6, 2025**, the Concours musical international de Montréal (CMIM) celebrates the art of singing.

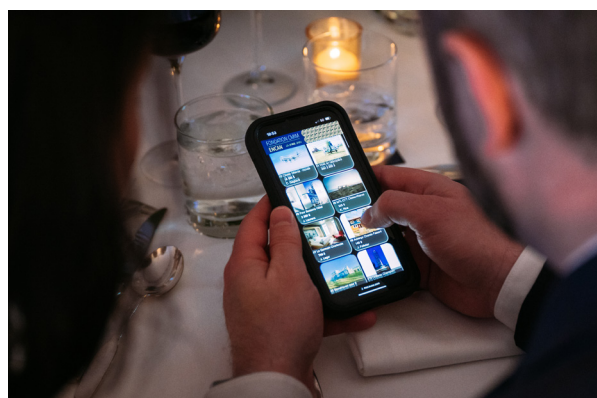
